Their Chicago Men’s Fashion Award Winners will be officially announced on August 22nd at Suitsupply. The 2017 Co-Chairs are Peggy Martay, David Mordini, Quenten Schumacher and Karen Zupko.

"The Chicago History Museum houses a significant collection of menswear dating from the late 1700s to the present. National treasures include clothing and accessories worn by Presidents George Washington, John Adams and Abraham Lincoln along with attire associated with many Chicago and Illinois politicians. Represented are bespoke suits from the city’s most distinguished tailors and international styles by designers such as Gianni Versace, Calvin Klein, Issey Miyake, and Yohji Yamamoto. The museum houses sports uniforms worn by notable athletes such as Stan Makita, Michael Jordan, and Doug Buffone as well as clothing and accessories worn by cultural icons like Studs Terkel and Sir Georg Solti. From the renowned to the unknown, the clothing in the collection represents functional and personal affiliations as well as the evolution of men’s fashionable silhouettes from the late 1700s into the 21st century."
